The population of Lake County is projected to grow 50% by 2030. How will we manage this growth? How can we preserve quality of life and ensure prosperity, equality and economic opportunity for future generations?

Don't miss this important opportunity to help shape our county's future! Join your friends and neighbors at one of five upcoming community workshops sponsored by the Lake County/City Area Planning Council.

Participants will be able to review the Lake County 2030 Blueprint Vision and Principles that emerged from a series of public workshops held in 2009 and then take it a step further—learn about and comment on four alternative growth scenarios (Recent Trends, Inward Focus, Large New Developments, and Managed Growth) that show how Lake County could develop under different growth assumptions and policies. Then evaluate how these scenarios fit the Vision and Principles. From the results of the workshops and a Web survey that will be available on www.lakeapc.org in March, Lake APC will develop a Preferred Growth Scenario for the future that will be offered as guidance to planners in the unincorporated area of Lake County, and the cities of Clearlake and Lakeport.
